I / We the undersigned wishing to become a Member of Species 2000 hereby undertake that if admitted to membership I / we will use my / our best endeavours to advance and promote the interests of the Company as set out in its Memorandum and Articles of Association.

I / we also undertake to contribute to the assets of the Company in the event of the same being wound up while I am / we are a Member or within one year of ceasing to be a Member, for payments and liabilities of the Company contracted before I / we ceased to be a Member, and of costs, charges and expenses of winding-up and for the adjustment of the rights of members amongst themselves such amount as may be required not exceeding one pound sterling.

Becoming a member of Species 2000 does not commit the Member to provide access to all or part of any databases which they may have. However for those who would like to be specific about this, the following additional paragraph is suggested:

This application is without prejudice to subsequent decisions and licence agreements concerning taxonomic databases that I / we may make available for access through Species 2000.
